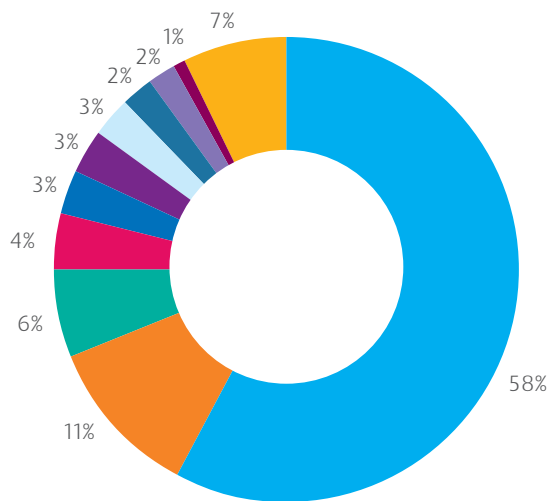

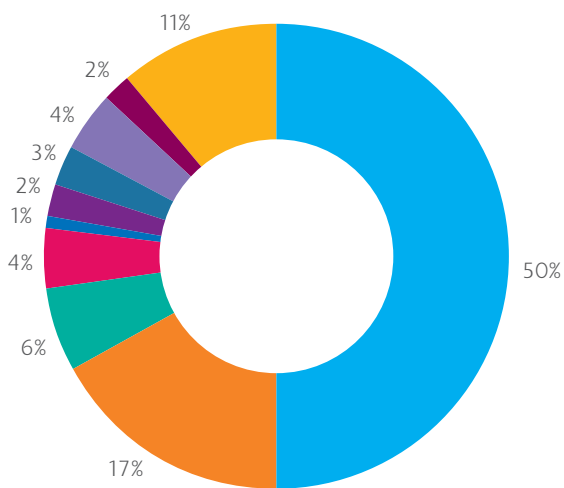

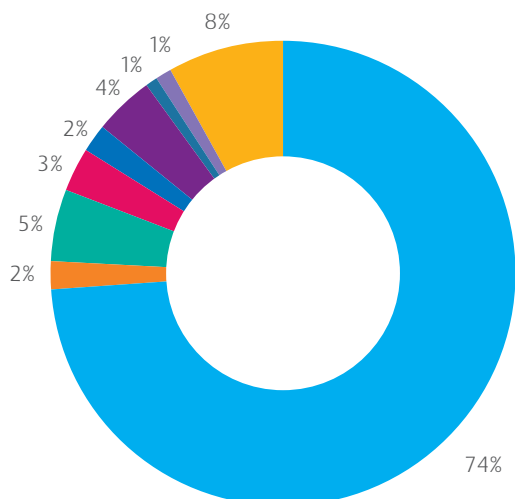

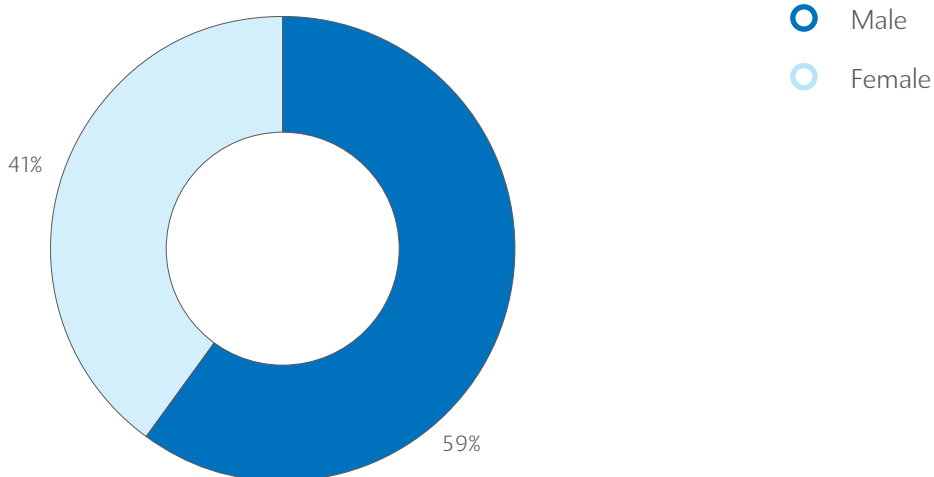
Male Bupa Individual Protection Critical Illness claims



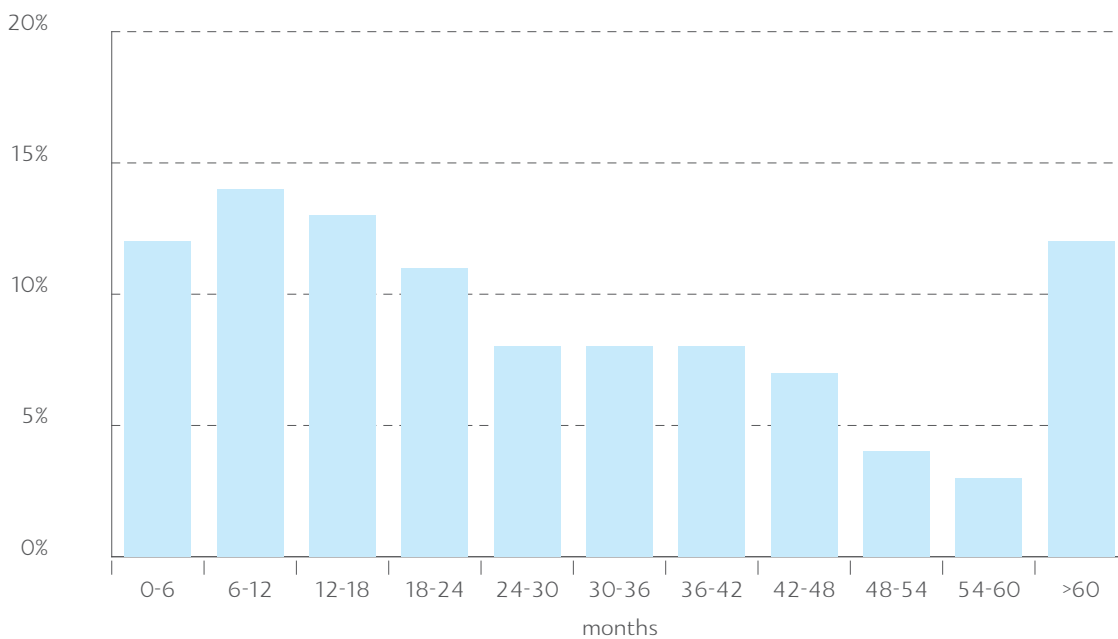
Female Bupa Individual Protection Critical Illness claims



Paid claims by gender



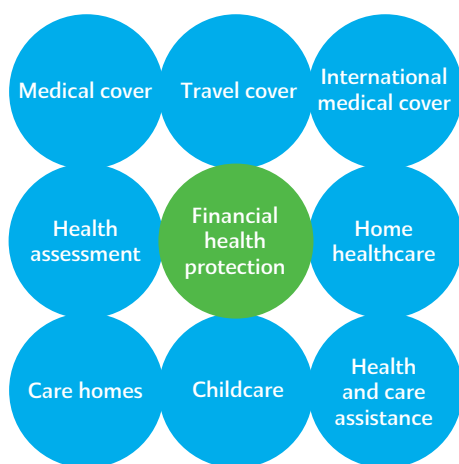
Paid claims by duration of policy in-force
